Take I-10 E toward Pensacola (crossing into Florida) (52.7 mi.) Take the US-90 Exit 17 toward Pensacola (0.2 mi.) Turn right onto Scenic Hwy./US-90/FL-10A (1.2 mi.) Turn Right onto Creighton Road/FL-74 2 (1.3 mi.) End at 3600 Creighton Road.

From Panama City:

Take US-98/W 15th/FL-30A. Continue to follow US-98 W. (35.5 mi) Turn Slight right onto US-331/FL-83 (9.7 mi.) Turn left onto US-331/FL-83/FL-20 (1.0 mi.) Turn right onto US-331/FL-83. Continue to follow FL-83 N. (14.1 mi.) Merge onto I-10 W via the ramp on the left toward Pensacola (68.1 mi.) Take the US-90 Exit 17 toward Pensacola (0.2 mi.) Turn onto Scenic Hwy./Hwy 90/FL-10A (1.2 mi.) Turn right onto Creighton Rd/FL-742 (1.3 mi.) End at 3600 Creighton Road
